## Rules of the Society

### Membership

Application for membership shall be by completion of a Membership Application form, which shall be sent to the Membership Secretary with payment for the respective subscription. The Membership Secretary shall then present the application form to the Society's Committee who shall approve or reject the application. The Committee's decision is final.

### Subscriptions

As from 4th October 2018 there shall only be two forms of subscriptions, both being life members:

1. Ordinary life members shall pay a one-off payment of £20.00 and will be considered a member for life irrespective of any increase in life subscriptions.
2. Associate life members shall pay a one-off payment of £30.00 and will be considered a member for life irrespective of any increase in life subscriptions.

### Benefits

1. All Members and Associate Members are entitled to attend the Society's Annual Dinner, held in October each year.
2. All Members and Associate Members are entitled to apply for membership of any of the Society's sub-sections, such as the Golf Society.

### Discipline

Any Member who has a complaint made against their conduct may be summoned to appear before the Society's committee. If the committee find evidence to prove the complaint they may:

1. Call on the Member to resign.
2. Remove the Member's name from the register of members.
3. Suspend the Member for a stated period.
4. Otherwise deal with the Member as may be necessary.

### Alteration to Rules

Alteration to these rules may be done at any committee meeting by a simple majority.
